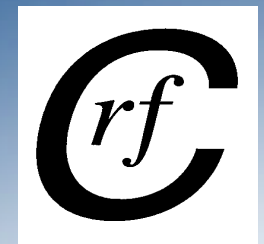

# British Sugar history



First factory at Cantley – 1912

Further 17 established during the 1920's

1936 Sugar Industry Act

- British Sugar Corporation

Acquired by ABF January 1991

# British Sugar today

Sole processor of UK sugar  
beet crop

Six factories

1.3 million tonnes of sugar  
(1.1 million tonnes EU quota)

Market leader in industrial and retail  
markets



# Agriculture



7,000 growers contracted

Crop area covers 135,000 hectares

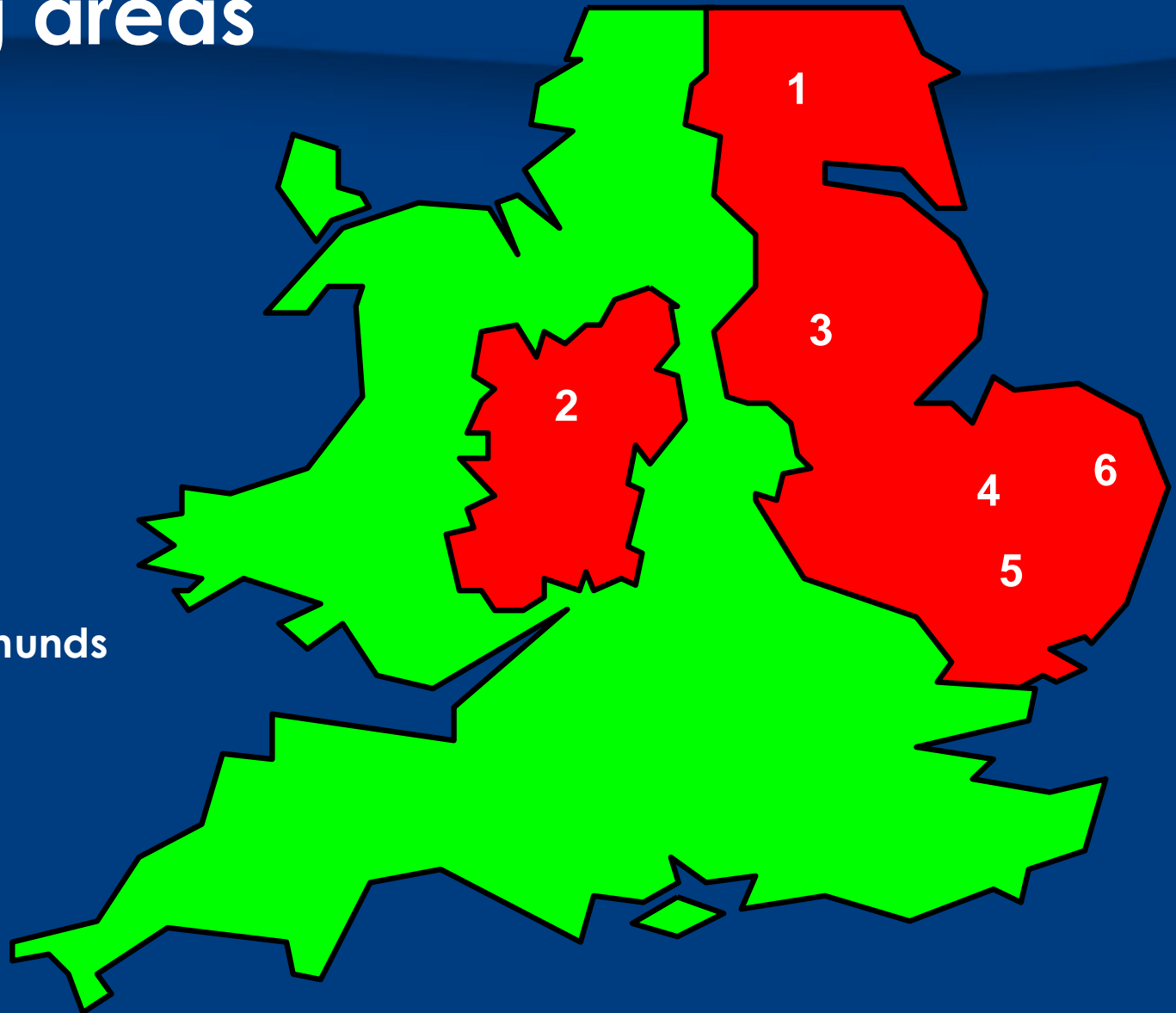
9M tonnes beet delivered annually

# Trident Feeds
